Dear Mr. President:

Today, we are exposed to 100 million times more background RF radiation today than our grandparents were. This is why I would like to request that you establish “white zones” throughout the United States; sanctuaries from toxic levels of microwave radiation. While all of us are harmed by the high levels of radiofrequency radiation present in our environment today, the majority of people do not connect their symptoms and adverse health effects that they experience to wireless devices and wireless electronics. Today, thousands of us have had to flee our homes; many of us now sleep in our cars since smart-meters are being forced onto our homes, making the radiation levels at home intolerable for sleeping. Increasingly, we cannot live in modern cities, where pesticides, chemicals, and radiofrequency radiation have made life extremely difficult for us. While some of us are able to find refuge in the country or in the woods, it is becoming harder and harder to find isolated places in the United States where the natural background levels of radiofrequency radiation still remain low. After all, Green Bank was founded for science, not for health.

We are fleeing our homes and jobs, and the numbers afflicted keep rising. Please do not forget us. Please stick to your promise and fight for all of us.
